To support literacy in all areas, a variety of resources will be used including: Bug Club, Active Spelling boards, Colorful Semantics and Co- writer 6 for writing. Peer reading will be promoted to develop listening and talking skills. This will be further developed by the Butterfly Room boys leading the sessions with their own choice of reading materials. Please continue to read with your children to encourage progression in reading skills for accuracy and fluency.

In our writing, pupils will be exploring a wide range of genres within the curriculum. This term, we are focusing on recount writing and narrative. This will develop writing skills and pupils will be able to apply new skills across other curricular areas.
