Termly Overview – Term 1 – 2025/26



Literacy & English



- Reading and Spelling – Pupils will develop reading and spelling skills through the Read Write Inc. programme. In your child's Seesaw account, you will find activities which link to the current sounds your child is learning.
- Writing – Fine-motor skills development to support letter and number formation. Activities linked to this will be shared on Seesaw too.
- Phonological awareness will be developed through songs, rhymes and stories.



Numeracy & Mathematics

- Please check your child's Seesaw account for a range of home learning activities that can be followed to reinforce class learning.
- Numeracy: learning to read, write, count and order numbers up to 5/10/20 and beyond.
- Time: days of the week, months of the year, calendars and sequencing events.
- Fractions: finding halves through sharing.
- Measurement: lengths and using comparative language.
- Money: recognising coins to £2.



Health & Wellbeing



Our PE focus this term is Team Invasion Games. PE days are as follows:

We are using Emotion Works to learn about Emotion Words and Emotion Behaviours through stories and other texts.

A whole school focus is to learn about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). This term we are particularly focusing on Article 24, 26 and 28.

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

We follow a play-based approach in Primary 1, therefore we follow the children's interests and plan the curriculum accordingly.

Mrs Paton will be teaching both classes drama linked to traditional tales and French.

The Youth Music Initiative (YMI) will be running a block of music lessons from September to November consisting of music-making, ensemble playing, and instrumental learning.
