We are using Emotion Works to learn about Emotion Words and Emotion Behaviours through stories and other texts.

We are learning about our decider skills which we have had introduced via assembly which work closely with Emotion works.

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

This term we are teaching P3 pupils about Scottish Castles.

Through this topic we will focus on People, Past Events & Societies, Literacy and Expressive Arts.

This term we will continue to develop our pupils' wider interests that we capture from play and big questions. We will link these to a range of curricular areas this term.

Mrs Paton is also teaching all of the children art skills through their class novels. She is also broadening the children's French vocabulary.

We are also exploring diversity in our community by learning about a variety of religious celebrations and global events coming up in the next few months.

A whole school focus is to learn about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and we continue to learn and discuss in class. This term we are thinking about Article 28, 24 and 2d. These will be linked to our everyday learning
