Termly Overview – Term 1 – 2025/26

Literacy & English

Reading

Pupils will be using Reciprocal Reading Strategies (Predicting, Summarising, Clarifying and Questioning) to deepen their understanding of different types of texts. There will also be a focus on fluency and expression within reading.

Writing

In writing, the children will be focusing on describing bubbles to enhance their descriptive language in writing. We will be learning about and using abstract nouns, adjectives, adverbials and adverbs. We will also look at procedural writing where pupils will learn how to give clear, step-by-step instructions.

Health & Wellbeing

Physical Education

Our PE days are Monday and Friday. The key focus of Term 1 has been team invasion games, working on developing hand-eye co-ordination and team building skills.

Health and Wellbeing

The children will explore regulation strategies by using Emotion Works and Zones of Regulation resources. This will enable pupils to build a bank of strategies to help them regulate their emotions when required.

Pupils are working on building and maintaining positive relationships with their peers through team work.

Numeracy & Mathematics

Place Value

We are revisiting how to order numbers, dividing and multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000, rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10000.

Addition and Subtraction

Pupils will revisit strategies to add and subtract a variety of 3-6 digit numbers.

Multiplication and Division

The pupils are refreshing their times table knowledge and completing weekly CLIC Tests. Pupils should be encouraged to practise their times tables at home to improve fluency. This can be done through Hit the Button.

Data Handling

Pupils will be looking at gathering and displaying data in order to support them in analysing the data gathered.

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

Discovery Learning (Titanic)

The pupils are exploring different elements of the curriculum through their Titanic topic. Pupils will be developing their metaskills through a range of different activities suited to their interests.

Expressive Arts

Music: The children will be looking at rhythm and stave notation to gain an understanding of reading music with Graeme High music specialist Mr Burke.

Art: The children are focusing on experimenting with a variety of media to create themed artwork linked to famous self-portraits and Rights Respecting Schools with Mrs Paton. There will also be opportunities for art throughout the class's topic of the Titanic.
