Literacy & English

Reading: Pupils will be using Reciprocal Reading Strategies (Predicting, Summarising, Clarifying and Questioning) to deepen their understanding of different types of texts. Our class novel is *The First Year* by Matt Goodfellow. This is the next in the series, focusing on the first year in High School; it includes potential issues the children may face as they transition to S1.

Writing: We continue to learn about and use proper and common nouns, adjectives, and adverbs. We will also be working on narrative and recount writing.

Talking and Listening: We will be working on teaching children to listen skills and our Class novel

ERIC – (Everyone Reads in Class, logo above) This term we will read eBooks and listen to audiobooks using our iPads.

Health & Wellbeing

Numeracy & Mathematics

Money/Data Analysis: We will learning about budgeting through our WWII topic, including rationing, as well as completing a project on organising a charity fundraiser. We will record our information in tables and graphs.

Number and Number Processes: We will be working on mental addition and subtraction as well as adding and subtracting numbers to three decimal places.

Shape: We will further develop our knowledge of 3d shapes.

Angles and symmetry: We will be drawing angles and improving our understanding of supplementary angles.

Tables: We are revising all multiplication tables previously learned and setting targets for new ones.

Children should be encouraged to practise their times tables at home to improve fluency. Continuous work on Hit the Button would be very helpful to support times tables knowledge.

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

For our IDL topic will be learning about WWII. This will include the people involved, the past events and how this affected society.

Our focus for Global Goals is Climate Action.

We will explore the connections of kindness in all religions in particular Christianity in the run up to Christmas.

Expressive Arts will include Music, Art and Drama.

In Technologies we will use the ipads and laptops.

We incorporate French in our daily routines and are also working on our Spanish and Makaton.
