Termly Overview – Term 2 – 2025/26



Literacy & English



RWI (Read, Write, Inc.) – This term pupils will continue developing their Reading, Spelling and Writing skills through Read Write Inc. (RWI). We will continue to work with the P3 and P4 classes in our RWI groups. This happens three times each week.

Spelling – The children will continue to practise their Red Word spelling words in class. These will also be shared on Seesaw so the children can learn at home too.

Writing – We are continuing our P2 writing journey using Colourful Semantics ‘who, doing, what, where’ and improving our sentence structure using capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and correct letter formation. We will also be working on ‘reading our work’ and checking it makes sense. P2S will continue to be supported by Mrs Lamb during writing time.

Book of the Fortnight – The children have thoroughly enjoyed our Books of the Fortnight, and this will continue this term. We have had a lot of fun taking part in various activities around these books and we look forward to more this term.



Numeracy & Mathematics

This term P2 will focus on rounding, as well as addition and subtraction in Numeracy. We will learn the rules about when to round up and round down, and how you choose this. We will work on addition and subtraction within 20, and continue to practise our recall of number bonds of 10 and 20.

In outer maths we will learn about symmetry and angles as well as data handling – working on how to gather as well as display a range of data.



Health & Wellbeing



P2 PE Days

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Miss Hurst will be continuing with core skills throughout PE lessons, focusing on developing children's co-ordination, teamwork and confidence. Miss Stewart will be focusing on basketball. The children will learn ball skills, decision making in the game and balance and control.

Pupils can wear their PE kit to school with a school jumper/cardigan on top. Long hair should be tied back, jewellery/watches/ earrings removed, and appropriate footwear worn.

We are continuing our work around Emotion Works to learn about triggers, emotion words, behaviors, and regulation strategies, through stories, texts, and art. We will also be learning about medicines, unsafe situations, and emergencies during our Health & Wellbeing time in class.



Interdisciplinary Learning & Other



This term we are teaching P2 pupils about our local area, local services, and people who help us. If you work or volunteer in the local community and wish to come and speak to our classes, please get in touch with us, we would love to hear from you! This term we will start our community groups. This is a school wide approach where pupils will be involved in different aspects of the wider school community. More information on this to follow.

A whole school focus is to learn about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and we continue to learn and discuss these through books and other sources.

Mrs Paton will teach art lessons once a week. Mr Champlin will teach in P2S on a Tuesday.
