Literacy & English

Reading

Pupils will be using Reciprocal Reading Strategies (Predicting, Summarising, Clarifying and Questioning) within their reading groups with their chosen book. Pupils will be encouraged to read aloud to their teacher and classmates to increase reading fluency and confidence.

Writing

In writing, the children will be focusing on creating texts which persuade the reader. This will be linked to their social enterprise topic. The term, we will also focus on creating narrative texts and looking at setting and characterisation.

Numeracy & Mathematics

Multiplication and Division

The pupils are learning different strategies to help them multiply and divide numbers. We are continuously working on times table recall.

Data Handling

Through their social enterprise topic, Primary 6 will be looking at gathering and displaying data in order to support them in making informed decisions.

Shape

Pupils will work at identifying and naming 2D and 3D shapes and work on creating nets for 3D shapes.

Angles and Symmetry

We will be looking at how to work out complementary and supplementary angles, types of angles (acute, obtuse, reflex) and lines of symmetry.

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

Social Enterprise

The pupils will be working on creating business ideas to create a Social Enterprise business for our school. They will learn about what makes a good business, how to advertise and how to budget. This will enable our Primary 6s to develop workforce skills and to start thinking like young entrepreneurs.

Expressive Arts

Music: Mr Burke from Graeme High School will be teaching about different types of instruments and how they are used: woodwind, brass, strings. Pupils will get the opportunity to learn to read stave music and play instruments in the classroom.

Art: The children are focusing on experimenting with a variety of media to create themed artwork linked to different artists and styles with Mrs Paton. There will also be opportunities for graphic design through our social enterprise topic by creating logos and posters.
