Termly Overview – Term 3 – 2025/26



Literacy & English



RWI (Read, Write, Inc.) – This term pupils will continue with learning reading, spelling and writing skills through Read Write Inc. (RWI). We will continue to work with the P3 and P4 classes in our RWI groups. This happens three times each week.

Spelling – The children will continue to practise their Red Word spelling words in class. These will continue to be shared on Seesaw so the children can learn at home too.

Writing – We are continuing our P2 writing journey using Colourful Semantics and 'writing about the picture'. P2S will be supported by Mrs Lamb during writing time.

Book of the Fortnight – Book of the Fortnight will continue this term. January will have a specific focus on books using Scots language.

Scots – There will be a focus in January on Scots poetry and text in preparation for our Scots Assembly celebration event.

Numeracy & Mathematics



This term P2 will focus on the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) in numeracy.

We will be starting a number bonds and times table challenge this term. More information about this will be shared on Seesaw, and how you can support your child at home with this.

In our maths, we will work on patterns and relationships and shape. We will also revisit telling the time.



Health & Wellbeing



PE days will remain the same for this term, Wednesday with Miss Stewart and Friday with Miss Hurst.

Our PE focus this term is on a range of sports, beginning with gymnastics. Pupils should come prepared for PE, wearing their PE kit to school with a school jumper/cardigan on top for the duration of the school day. Long hair should be tied back, jewelry/watches/earrings removed, and appropriate footwear worn. We are continuing our work around Emotion Works to learn about triggers, emotion words, behaviors, and regulation strategies, through stories, texts, and art.

We will also be learning about RSHP (Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood) during our Health & Wellbeing time in class. Please see the link attached to this message for further information on RSHP at P2 level.



Interdisciplinary Learning & Other



This term we are teaching P2 pupils about Scottish food and drinks to tie in with our Scots literacy topics.

We will continue with community groups this term. This is a school wide approach where pupils will be involved in different aspects of the wider school community.

A whole school focus is to learn about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and we continue to learn and discuss these through books and other sources.

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In Term 3, we will celebrate World Religion Day. We will learn about Ramadan, Shrove Tuesday, Holi and Eid.
