Termly Overview – Term 3 – 2025/26

Literacy & English

Reading

Pupils will be using Reciprocal Reading Strategies (Predicting, Summarising, Clarifying and Questioning) within their reading groups with their chosen book. Pupils will be encouraged to read aloud to their teacher and classmates to increase reading fluency and confidence.

Writing

In writing, the children will be focusing on poetry and writing their own Haikus and Limericks. The children will also be focusing on persuasive and explanation writing. A key skill focus this term is comprehension and understanding of questions.

Talking and Listening

Numeracy & Mathematics

Fractions, Percentages and Decimals

The class will be working on identifying fractions, percentages and decimals through visual representation. We will be looking at division strategies to develop finding fractions and percentages of an amount.

Measure

The class will be focusing on perimeter, area and volume. The children will be utilising the outdoor space to facilitate this learning.

Time

The class will be working on different aspects of time such as reading 12 and 24 hour times using analogue and digital time. We will be looking at timetables and strategies to develop calculating periods of time.

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

Children's Rights

UNCRC Right of the Month – Article 7 - You have the right to a name and a nationality.

Scots Topic

The pupils will be researching and learning about Mary Queen of Scots. They will also be learning about Scots language through the Mary Queen of Scots topic and our Scottish Poetry.

European Union

The pupils will be learning about the different countries of the European Union: capital cities, landmarks, geographical features. Pupils will get the opportunity to compete as a Euroquiz team to represent our school.

Expressive Arts

Music: Mr. Burke from Graeme High School will be teaching about different types of instruments and how they are used: woodwind, brass, strings. Pupils will get the opportunity to learn to read stave music and play instruments in the classroom.

Art: The children are focusing on experimenting with a variety of media to create themed artwork linked to different artists and styles with Mrs Paton. In January, Mrs Paton will be focusing on Charles Rennie Mackintosh.
