Literacy & English

Reading

Pupils will be using Reciprocal Reading Strategies (Predicting, Summarising, Clarifying and Questioning) within their reading groups with their chosen book. During their novel study, there will be a focus on learning about inferencing. Pupils will be encouraged to read aloud to their teacher and classmates to increase reading fluency and confidence.

Writing

In writing, the children will be focusing report writing, discursive and narrative writing. We will focus on our topic of Space for our report writing, we will write an informative report about space and the planets in our solar system.

Numeracy & Mathematics

Fractions, Percentages and Decimals

The class will be working on identifying fractions, percentages and decimals through visual representation. We will be looking at division strategies to develop finding fractions and percentages of an amount.

Multiples, Factors and Primes

The class will be focusing on multiples, factors and primes.

Expressions and equations

The class will look at equations such as $4X=9$.

Money

The class will be working on different aspects of money such as budgeting, foreign exchange, profit and loss. This links to our financial Fortnight where we will focus on budgeting a party and a 'save the egg' budgeting challenge.

Patterns and relationships

The class will focus on lineal sequence and graphical representation, we will utilise the outdoors to complete this learning.

Measure

The class will be focusing on perimeter, area and volume. The children will be utilising the outdoor space to facilitate this learning.
