## Termly Overview – Term 4 – 2025/26



### Literacy & English



**RWI (Read, Write, Inc.)** – In our last term in P2, pupils will continue with learning Reading, Spelling and Writing skills through Read Write Inc. (RWI). We will continue with all P2 and P3 classes working alongside their RWI groups to continue making progress – this happens three times each week.

**Spelling** – The children will continue to practise their Red Word spelling words in class. These will continue to be shared on Seesaw so the children can learn at home too.

**Writing** – We are continuing our P2 writing journey using Colourful Semantics and 'writing about the picture'. We will be extending our writing by using 2, and 3, part stories. We will also be exploring fiction and non-fiction texts. P2LK will be supported by Mrs McLean during writing time.

**Book of the Fortnight** – Book of the Fortnight will continue this term, we will be exploring different themes and genres of books and stories.

### Numeracy & Mathematics



In our final term of P2, we will continue to focus on the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) in Numeracy. We will also be learning about simple fractions.

For Outer Maths we will be covering a variety of areas such as Chance and Uncertainty, revising telling the Time, and discovering information about Scottish Mathematicians.

We will continue practising number bonds via the Number Bond Challenge.



### Health & Wellbeing



PE days will remain the same for this term, Monday and Thursday.

Our PE focus this term is on a range of sports. Pupils should come prepared for PE, wearing their PE kit to school with a school jumper/cardigan on top for the duration of the school day. Long hair should be tied back, jewelry/watches/ earrings removed, and appropriate footwear worn.

We are continuing our work around Emotion Works to learn about triggers, emotion words, behaviors, and regulation strategies, through stories, texts, and art.

We will also be learning about RSHP (Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood) during our Health & Wellbeing time in class. More information will come out nearer the time.



### Interdisciplinary Learning & Other



This term we are teaching P2 pupils about our World of Work, where we will be learning about a variety of jobs in our local area. We would to invite family members to come in and talk to the children about their job. Please get in contact with your child's class teacher if this is something you could help us with.

We will continue to develop our pupils' wider interests that we capture from play and big questions. We will continue to link these to a range of curricular areas this term.

A whole school focus is to learn about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and we continue to learn and discuss these through books and other sources.

Our term 4 focus for RME will be Christianity, Islam and our new school values of Kindness, Respect and Trust.
