Literacy & English



• Reading and Spelling – Pupils will develop reading and spelling skills through the Read Write Inc. programme. P4 enjoy reading in class (ERIC), outdoors (ERO) and in our school library.

• P4WB Class Novel – Chanda and the Devious Doubt

• P4M Class Novel – The Wild Robot

• Writing – We will be working on Describing Bubbles, Write about the Picture and Narrative. These help develop descriptive writing which can be used across all genres.



Numeracy & Mathematics

This term in Numeracy and Maths we will be looking at:

- Place Value
- Ordering numbers
- Times tables
- Data Analysis
- Angles and Symmetry
- Mental Addition and Subtraction

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

This term we are teaching P4 pupils about the Victoria Primary School Learning powers (5 Rs): Respectful, Responsible, Ready, Reflective and Resilient.

This term we will be focussing on Space as our topic. We will look at the Sun, Moon and stars as well as the planets. We will also learn about Space Exploration.

P4 will work together in Outdoor Learning lessons each week in Term 1.

A whole school focus is to learn about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and we continue to learn and discuss in class.
