Termly Overview – Term 1 – 2026/27

Literacy & English

In The Snug, we spend lots of time everyday writing, mark making, engaging with books and playing with alphabet games. All the play experiences created for us help us develop our love of Literacy! Every activity is tailored to each child's ability and interests, but we have whole class goals.

This term, our main Literacy targets are:

- **Identify 'Who' is in a book.** We will be using Book of the Fortnight to help us with this learning. Our current book is 'Oh Dear!'
- **Recognise our own name.** Many areas and items in the class are labelled, and children are encouraged to recognise name labels with increased independence. This is such an important goal in Term 1 as we get to know the classroom environment.
- **Use words and signs to ask for help.** We are encouraging children to use words, Makaton or visual symbols to ask for help. This is how to sign for 'help'. Why not try this at home.



Numeracy & Mathematics

Just like with Literacy, we tailor all experiences to suit each child, whilst also focusing on a whole class goal.

This term, our Numeracy targets are:

- **Numbers to 10.** We are really enjoying counting, writing and matching numbers to ten, and especially enjoy singing songs to help us learn. Our favourite is: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dk9Yt1PqQiw&hl=en-GB>
- **The days of the week.** Every morning, we join in with Morning Group, where we discuss the day, weather and season. We are currently working on a class display to help reinforce this learning.

Interdisciplinary Learning & Other

All of our daily play provocations are inspired by our current interests, and special events in the lives of the whole Snug team.

Based on our Book of the Fortnight, we are really enjoying learning about farm animals at the moment.

As we have moved into September, we will also be looking at seasonal themes, such as Autumn, harvest, nature.
