Literacy

Writing:

- Create narratives
- Create reports based on our IDL topic (extreme weather)
- For all writing pupils will be expected to use a range of punctuation, for example capital letters, full stops, commas, exclamation marks and apostrophes. Pupils will also be expected to use cursive writing.

Spelling:

- Pupils will continue to follow the Active Literacy programme.

Reading:

- Pupils will be encouraged to read for enjoyment at school. We would appreciate if you could also encourage your child to read at home.
- Pupils will continue to read from the Bug Club reading scheme.

Talking and Listening:

- Pupils will be encouraged to show respect for the views of others and offer own viewpoint.
- Pupils will be expected to ask and respond to a range of questions.
- Pupils will be working on the difference between fact and opinion.
