Literacy

Writing:

- Create narratives
- Create reports based on our IDL topic (Natural Disasters)
- For all writing pupils will be expected to use a range of punctuation, for example capital letters, full stops, commas, exclamation marks and apostrophes. Pupils will also be expected to use cursive writing.

Spelling:

- Pupils will continue to follow the Active Literacy programme.

Reading:

- Pupils will be encouraged to read for enjoyment at school. We would appreciate if you could also encourage your child to read at home.
- Pupils will be issued with weekly Bug Club reading tasks at home and in school.

Talking and Listening:

- Pupils will be listening and talking with others for different purposes in order to exchange information, experiences, explanations, ideas and opinions.
- Pupils will be expected to ask and respond to a range of questions.
- Pupils will be developing skills in note taking, using their own words where appropriate.
